Tutor Senators

What they do:

- Represent their tutor group in the Student Senate.
- Collect views, suggestions and concerns from their tutor group and share them at meetings.
- Feed back key messages from the Senate to their tutor group.



House Captains

What they do:

- Lead their house in competitions, especially sport.
- Recruit and encourage students to join in.
- Help organise and run house events.



Subject Ambassadors

What they do:

- Promote a subject they love.
- Support teachers with displays, clubs, open evenings and subject events.
- Encourage younger students to join in.

Civic Leaders

What they do:

- Lead or support charity and community projects.
- Organise fundraising or volunteering events.
- Work on school improvement projects (e.g. wellbeing, environment)



Your Responsibilities

Help	- Help run inter-house competitions (scorekeeping, organising teams)
Lead	- Lead form-time discussions for student voice
Support	- Support community and charity projects
Be	- Be role models for younger students
